Emergency Communications to Parents

In light of the recent earthquakes please note that the following procedures are in place regarding school emergency communications. When there is an event of significance, such as an earthquake, the school will communicate by:

- a) Emailing to email addresses that receive school communications
- b) Sending out a Twitter message to parents who follow "wadestownschool"
- c) Placing a message on the Parent Portal.
- d) A text message will be sent to two contact numbers provided by the parents/caregiver.

In the event that we do need to send out an urgent notification, be aware that phone networks will be handling large volumes of traffic.

Please note the following regarding email communication:

If you wish to include an additional email address (eg workplace) to receive school emails (note that this will be for all school communication sent by email and not just emergencies), please send a copy of your name, child's name and room number and your email address to the office: office@wadestown.school.nz

Should there be an earthquake, the school will send out a message with wording such as:

- a) Everything is fine at Wadestown School the day will continue as normal.
- b) All OK at Wadestown School. For safety reasons please collect your child from school ASAP as they will not be released by themselves.
- c) Please collect your child ASAP.

If required to close, the school is obliged to ensure that all pupils are picked up by their parents or caregivers, or those authorised by them. Pupils may not leave the school without an authorised person, and the school must monitor and record when and by whom every child is collected. Parents complete an authority document as part of the enrolment process and this information is also updated at the beginning of each year. The information provides the school with your authority for school staff to release your child to people other than you. Please note that if you wish to collect your child at any time after an earthquake, even though the school may continue as normal, please come to the school office to sign them out.
