Have a great break, hopefully some good snow for the skiers, maybe some sun up north and more importantly some rest and recreation for students and families.

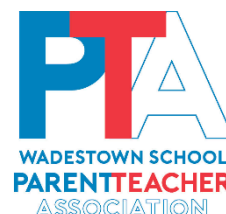
