**Covid Update:**

We continue to monitor trends and patterns from our end.

Most recently, we have had students presenting with headaches or sore stomachs at school. Both of these symptoms seem to come on quickly and have resulted in students then going on to test positive for Covid.

## Distance Learning

The feedback from families about the packs and online programmes has been positive and we are pleased that these are assisting families who are having to isolate.

A few points of clarification:

- If your child is unwell, there is no expectation that they engage in their distance learning. We would prefer that they rest and fully recover in the first instance. The research continues to point to the need for quality rest and relaxation as one of the key ways of recovering from Covid.
- The distance learning packs and programmes have been designed for students who either have Covid or who are having to isolate as a household contact. In the few instances where families are selecting to have their students stay at home for reasons other than this, please be aware that teachers are not able to provide additional distance learning programmes as our expectation is that they are at school.
